

United Kingdom

The United Kingdom, made up of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland, is an island nation in northwestern Europe. England – birthplace of Shakespeare and The Beatles – is home to the capital, London, a globally influential centre of finance and culture. England is also site of Neolithic Stonehenge, Bath's Roman spa and centuries-old universities at Oxford and Cambridge.



Most of the United Kingdom has a temperate climate, with generally cool temperatures and plentiful rainfall all year round. The temperature varies with the seasons seldom dropping below -20°C (-4°F) or rising above 35°C (95°F). Some parts, away from the coast, of upland England, Wales, Northern Ireland and most of Scotland, experience a sub polar oceanic climate (*Cfc*). Higher elevations in Scotland experience a continental subarctic climate (*Dfc*) and the mountains experience a tundra climate (*ET*). The prevailing wind is from the southwest and bears frequent spells of mild and wet weather from the Atlantic Ocean, although the eastern parts are mostly sheltered from this wind since the majority of the rain falls over the western regions the eastern parts are therefore the driest. Atlantic currents, warmed by the Gulf Stream,

bring mild winters; especially in the west where winters are wet and even more so over high ground. Summers are warmest in the southeast of England and coolest in the north. Heavy snowfall can occur in winter and early spring on high ground, and occasionally settles to great depth away from the hills.

FOR PR

After getting 2 years work visa in relevant field, then the student can apply – **99 years- PR (IRL- Card)**.

For getting IRL Card- Student is eligible after 3 years of work visa.

Student does not have to leave UK during job for 3 Years and job has to be relevant with studies.

For Spouse and Children Visa

Spouse and children are allowed in UK. It is mandatory that we should wait for the visa decision of the main applicant and then apply for spouse and children.



Visa Category: **TIER 4 GENERAL VISA**

Under this category

Main applicant will get 20 hours per week and spouse will get full time.

Documents Required:

1. Passport of main applicant.
2. Passport of spouse. (previous passport if any)
3. Bank Statement
4. CAS of the student (main applicant).

(If the student is in UK then the invitation is required from the main applicant).

5. Communication Record (if the student's spouse applies after a span of time).

If the student (main applicant) has funds else than the tuition fee paid then the main applicant can show funds for spouse.

ELSE

Spouse has to show funds.

If both have joint account, then the main applicant should be the first account holder.

Priority Visa

There are two priority visa for Main applicant:

Standard Visa: Fee- Rs. 55,000

Decision in 4 working days.

Super Priority Visa: Fee- Rs. 1,24,000

Decision in 24 hours

For Spouse, Only Priority Visa:

Decision in 4 weeks and in General- 8 weeks.

Fee: Rs. 55,000

For Spouse and children Health Insurance and medical will be same as main applicant.

For spouse- No academic documents or experience is required in filing.

For Children- Birth certificate is required.

Children upto 14 years can go.(schooling is free.)

Funds for spouse- Rs. 8,45,000

If student scored less than 45%, THEN he/she can go for **Pathway Program.**

- 1. Huddersfield- 5.5/5.5
- 2. Kingston- Less than 45%

If student is not meeting the requirement, then student can enter through pathway or foundation.
